

PETITION TO CONTEST ISSUANCE OF JUNK TITLE IN ILLINOIS BECAUSE OF PRIOR NMVTIS SEARCH

I hereby petition the Secretary of State for a hearing to reverse it's decision to issue a junk title certificate because a NMVTIS search revealed a prior designation, which is required to be equivalent to a junk designation in Illinois under federal law for the following reasons (check appropriate box(es) and add the appropriate information within each paragraph that is missing):

____ I contacted the state in which the prior designation of junk was considered equivalent to a junk designation in Illinois under federal law and that state indicated that a mistake was made in the submission of the original designation into the NMVTIS. The actual designation should have been _____.

____ I obtained an Illinois title for the vehicle from a transferor of the title, who last titled the vehicle before Aug. 20, 2015, and the vehicle is in safe and operational condition.

____ I choose not to contest the decision of the Secretary of State in issuing the junk title certificate in exchange for a copy of my previous car title (if available) so that I can attempt to sell the vehicle in another state.
